Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

A) CUSHION COVER - 40 PORTIONS

4) Pass long side strap through the opening between the molded

- plastic and the seat. Buckle to opposite side
- 5) Replace seat belt buckle to elastic on cover
- 6) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension

B) BACKREST COVER - 40 PORTIONS

5) Replace headrests (see note)

C) CUSHION COVER – 20 PORTION

- 1) Open cushion lid to up position
- 2) Slip cover over lid and attach velcro strips

1) Release seat belt buckle from elastic holder

2) Slip cover over backrest. (see air bag warning below)

3) Tuck flaps under backrest and attach to Velcro at back

2) Center cover on the seat

crevice and buckle to front

1) Remove head rest (see note)

3) With cushion lid closed, pass back flap through crevice between seat and plastic molding

3) With seat in highest position, pass back straps under seat through

D) BACKREST COVER - 20 PORTION

1) Remove headrest (see note)

- 2) Open zipper
- 3) Slip cover over backrest and under seat belt and close zipper

4) Snug cover at back of storage compartment so the Velcro on the cover

is positioned through the crevice where the lid and storage compartment are hinged

5)With backrest down, open storage compartment

6) Position adhesive backed velcro (supplied) to inside of storage

compartment to align with the velcro tabs on cover and attach. (see note)

Before positioning velcro, clean area with alcohol swab provided.

WARNING: DO NOT BLOCK AIR BAGS

1) Seats with integrated seat airbags must be covered only with seat covers designed with openings. Make sure that the openings in the sides of the seat covers are positioned so that the seat covers do not block or interfere with the deployment of the air bag. The attached flap tucks inside the cutout and should be able to open freely in case of deployment. 2) Constantly check your seat covers to ensure they are properly positioned to allow for complete air bag deployment.
