

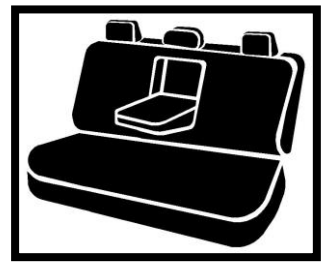

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

**A) BACKREST COVER**

- 1) Remove headrest (see note)
- 2) Remove seat belt buckle from elastic holder
- 3) Release backrest from the back wall by pulling the tab on backrest
- 4) Slip cover over backrest. Ensure cover is installed under seat belt
- 5) Smooth cover tightly from top to bottom. Cover has armrest opening
- 6) Tuck bottom of cover through crevice under backrest
- 7) Locate straps and secure to buckles on cover
- 8) Locate bottom right flap through crevice and hold at back of seat. With other hand bring the side flap around and attach (see note)
- 9) Repeat on left side
- 10) Replace previously removed seat belt buckle to elastic on cover
- 11) Make sure armrest opening is aligned with armrest.
- 12) Adjust all straps, buckles and velcro to equalize tension and ensure a snug fit
- 13) Re-install headrests (see note)

**B) CUSHION COVER**

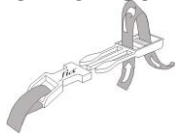
- 1) Center cover on the seat
- 2) Tuck back flap through crevice
- 3) Lift seat and pass straps under seat and buckle
- 4) Pass side straps and buckle
- 5) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension and ensure a snug fit

**C) ARMREST COVER**

- 1) Fold down armrest
- 2) Undo velcro closure on cover
- 3) Slip cover over armrest and re-attach previously undone velcro.
- 4) Position adhesive velcro supplied to align with velcro on cover
- around the edge of cupholder. **NOTE: BEFORE POSITION VELCRO, CLEAN AREA WITH ALCOHOL SWAB PROVIDED.**
- 5) Adjust all velcro to equalize tension

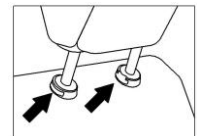


**3) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS**

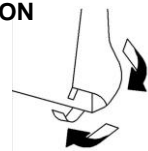
- A) Ensure pre-cut holes in seat cover align with holes in headrest base.
- B) Replace headrests

**2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:**

- Push in side release buttons
- Lift off
- (If unable to remove consult dealership)



**4) BOTTOM FLAP INSTALLATION**
