




	3. Flip the plate over and insert each of the four assembled stud plates into the front channel of the BASE RACK. Rotate 90 degrees and ensure the bolt on the two centre plate's lines up with the holes in the air deflector. The other 2 plates should be positioned near the ends of the channel.
	 Snap one u-nut onto each of the air deflector mounting plates. Take care to ensure the u-nut is oriented correctly. See image.
	 5. Attach all air deflector mounting plates to the stud plates with an M8 flat washer & nyloc nut. Leave nut loose enough to allow assembly to slide along channel.
FOR 17900	D90 ONLY
	For 17900080, proceed to step 15 For 17900100, proceed to step 10
	 Attach each of the end mounting brackets to a stud plate with an M8 flat washer & nyloc nut. Leave nut loose enough to allow assembly
	to slide along channel. NOTE: The end mounting brackets should be installed with the end return leaning towards the rear of the base rack.


