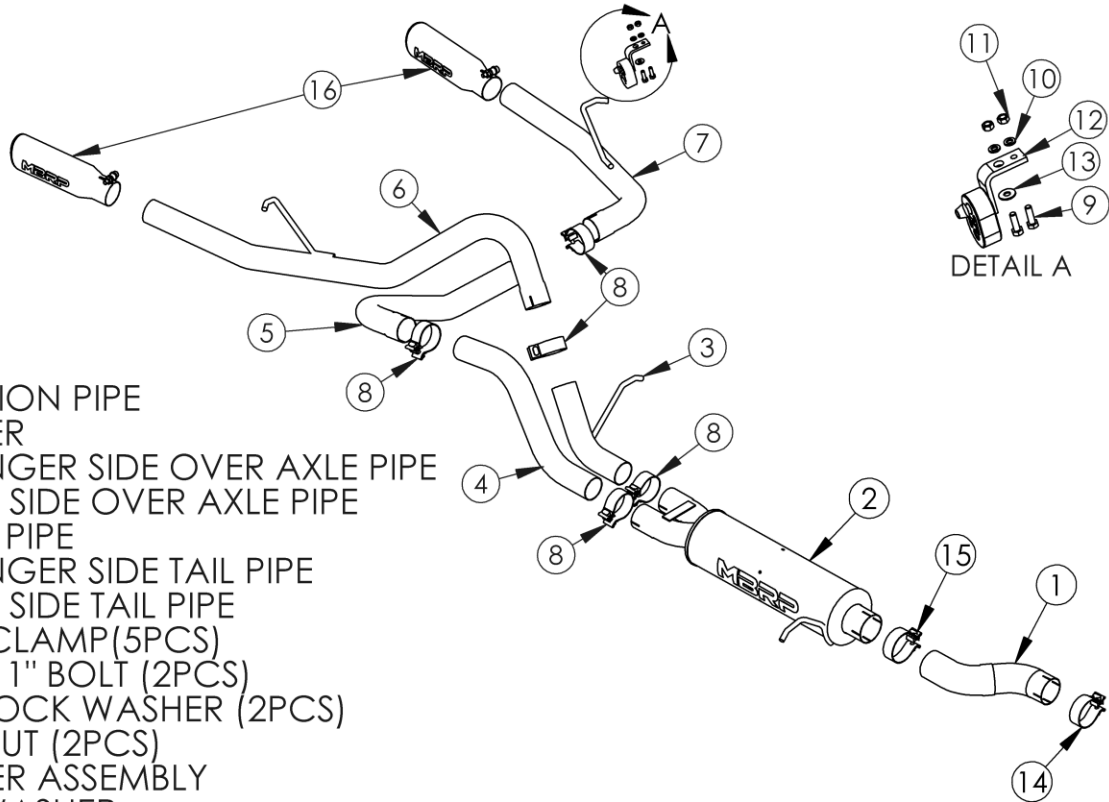

- that the system will not interfere with any modifications previously installed or planned.
- that you have read and understand these instructions.

## **Removal of Stock System:**

1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
2. Cut the exhaust in rear of the muffler so that the tail section can be removed from the vehicle.
3. Measure 4 1/2" in front of the cross member. The cross member is located just behind the Y-pipe. **Refer to Figure 2.**
4. Remove the hangers from the rubber insulators. Remove the exhaust from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 3.**
5. Remove spare tire from the vehicle and relocate.

## **Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:**

1. Install the **Extension Pipe** to the end of the Y-pipe using the 2 3/4" **Clamp**. **Refer to Figure 4.**

2. Slide a 2 ½” **Clamp** over the **Extension Pipe** and install the **Muffler Assembly** onto the **Extension Pipe**. Using another 2 ½” **Clamp** slide the **Passenger Side Over Axle Pipe** into the driver side of the **Muffler Assembly**. Attach the two hangers into to the existing rubber insulator at the front and back of the **Muffler Assembly**. **Refer to Figure 5**.

Note: Driver side of **Muffler Assembly** leads to **Passenger Side Tailpipe** and vice versa.

3. Slide a 2 ½” **Clamps** over the outlet of the **Passenger Side Over Axle Pipe**. Position the **Passenger Side Tail Pipe** and loosely attach it to the **Passenger Side Over Axle Pipe**. Install the **Passenger Side Tail Pipe** hanger into the existing rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 6**.

4. Loosely install the **Driver Side Over Axle Pipe** to the passenger side of the **Muffler**.

5. Slide a 2 ½” **Clamp** over the **Driver Side Over Axle Pipe** then loosely attach the **Cross Pipe** to the **Driver Side Over Axle Pipe**.

6. Install the **Hanger Assembly** using the fasteners provided. Note some vehicles may require drilling to enlarge the one hole.

7. Slide a 2 ½” **Clamp** onto the **Cross Pipe** and then attach the **Driver Side Tail Pipe** hanger into the **Hanger Assembly** and to the **Cross Pipe**. Refer to **Figure 10**.

8. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tips** to suit. Tighten the lock bolt located on each **Exhaust Tip**. Refer to **Figure 11**.

9. Carefully align the system and tips. Align the edge of each band clamp with the edge of the joint it is connecting. Tighten all hardware and clamps, starting at the front and working rearward to secure the system. Check along the full length of the exhaust system to ensure there is adequate clearance for fuel lines, vent lines, brake lines, frame, bodywork, suspension and any wiring, etc. If there is any interference detected, relocate or adjust to provide adequate clearance. Ensure all clamp connections are secure and components are unable to rotate or slide. Band clamps require approximately 45 lb-ft (60 N-m) of torque. Verify clearances, system security and band clamp torque after 30-60 miles (50-100 km) of driving.
