

DURING AND/OR AFTER INSTALLATION: Ensure emergency brake cables are not touch-ing the SuperSprings. Secure any cables out of the way with zip ties or by re-routing. **Ensure all A/C lines, brake cables, and frame are clear of contact or interference.**

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Your part may have been loosley preassembled to show the final product as it will be once installed on your vehicle. Please disassemble the product before proceeding to the installation.

INSTALLATION

1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place blocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Raise the rear of the Jeep, allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands. Removal of the rear wheel is optional.ar.

3. Remove the factory bump stop from the frame. The bump stop is easily removed by pulling and twisting it.

4. Install the SumoSprings [ITEM A] into the bump stop cup by pushing and twisting them into the same position as the factory bump stops.

- **5.** Repeat steps three and four on the opposite side of the vehicle.
- **6.** Reinstall the coil and reattach the sway bar, shocks, and track bar.

7. Raise the vehicle to allow room to remove the safety jack stands. Reinstall the rear wheels if they were removed during installation and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers spec.

8. Carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface and remove the blocks from the wheels.

9. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
